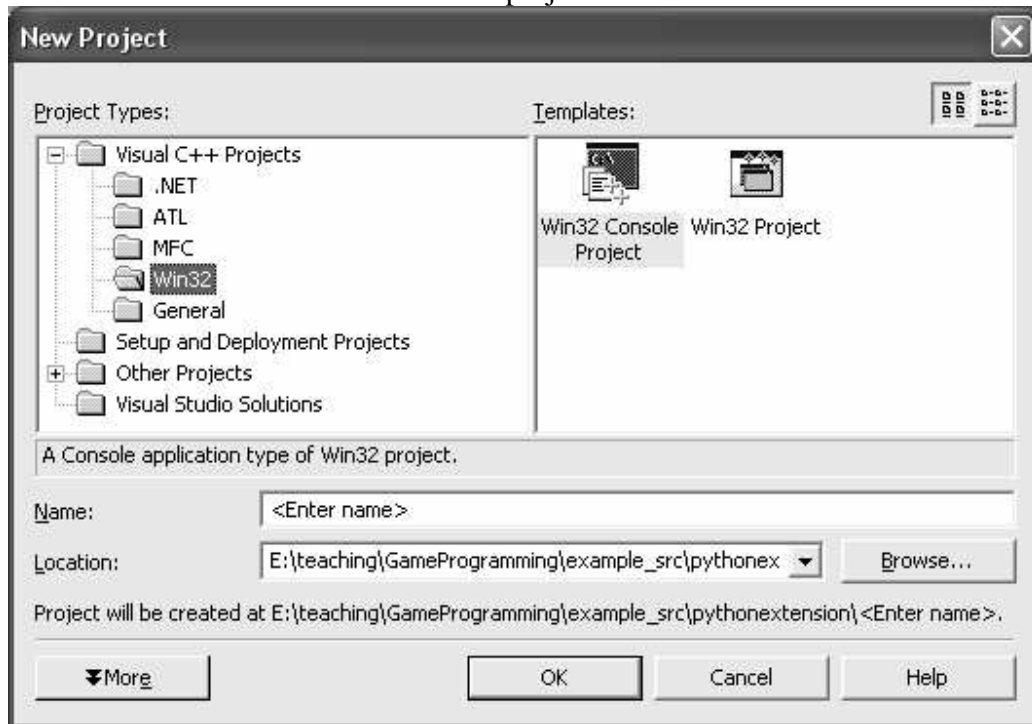
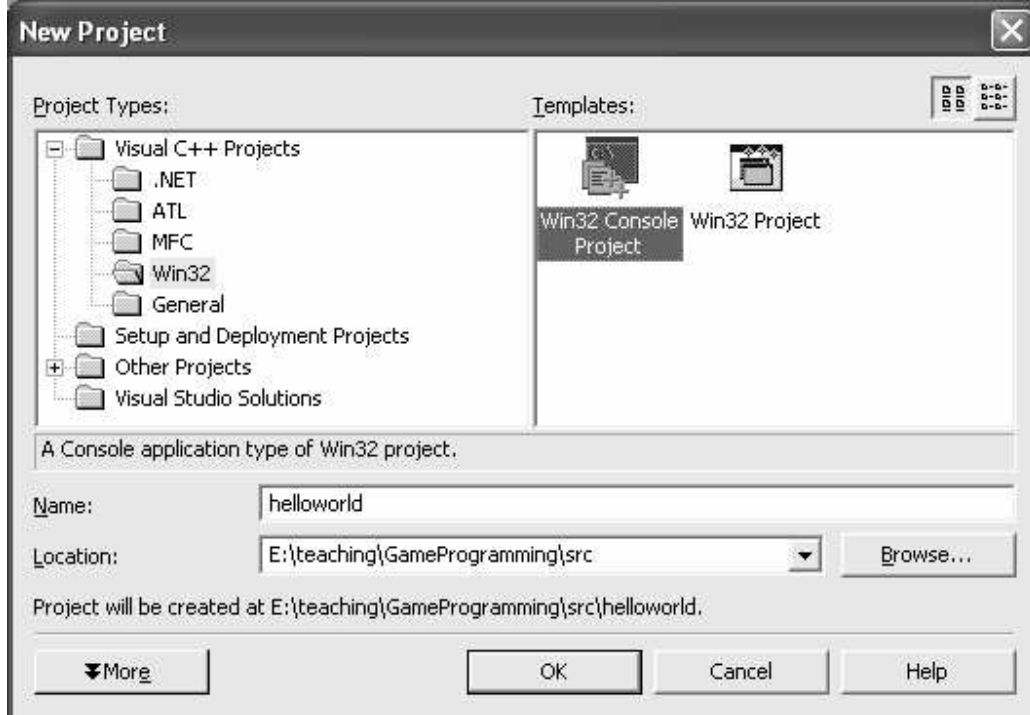


How to create a C++ project in Visual Studio .NET (2003)

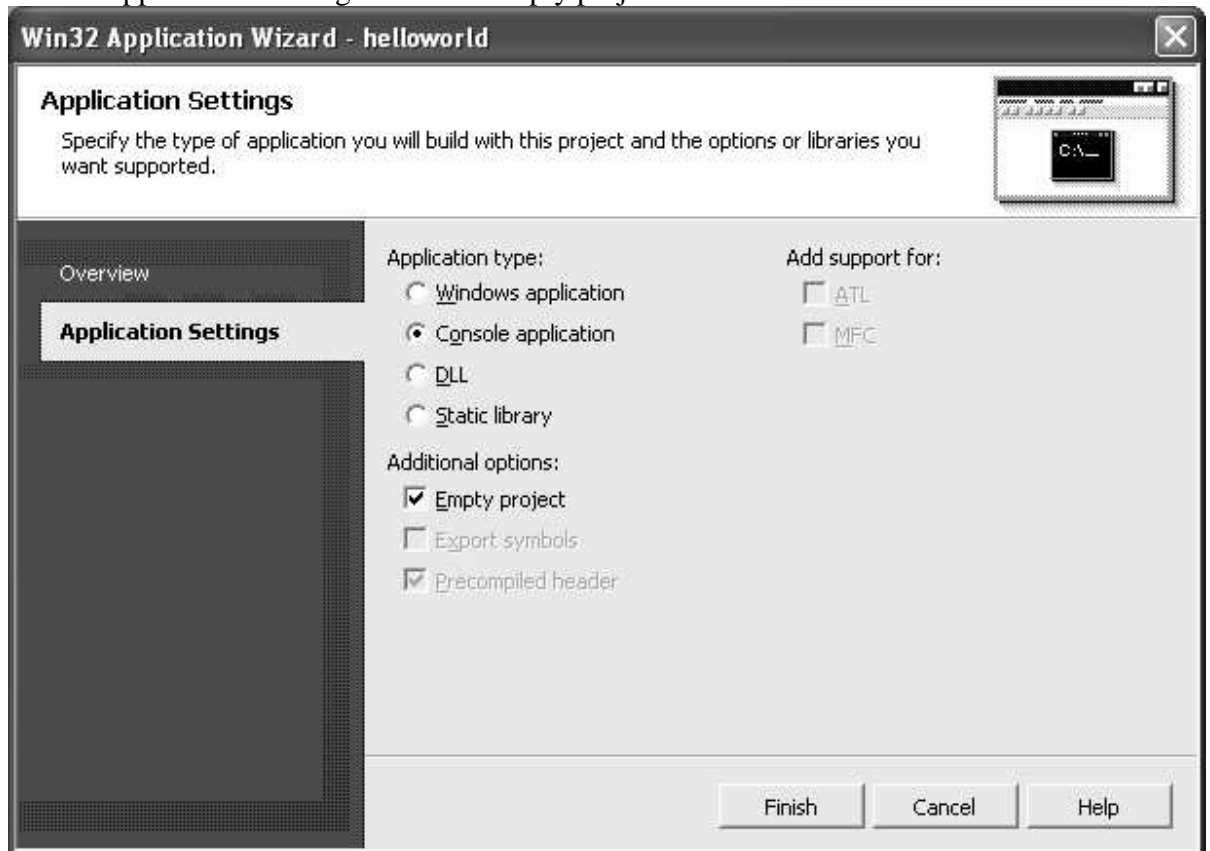
1. Start Visual studio. Choose file->new->project.



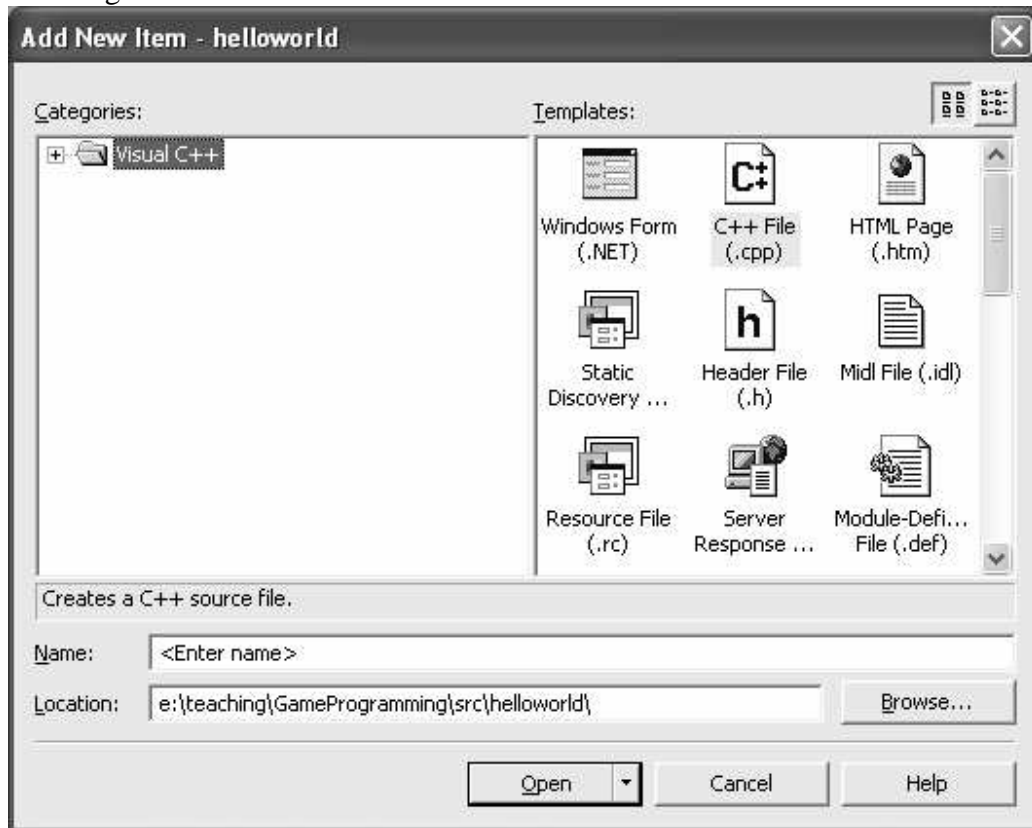
2. Choose a name and a location for your project and choose Win32 Console project.



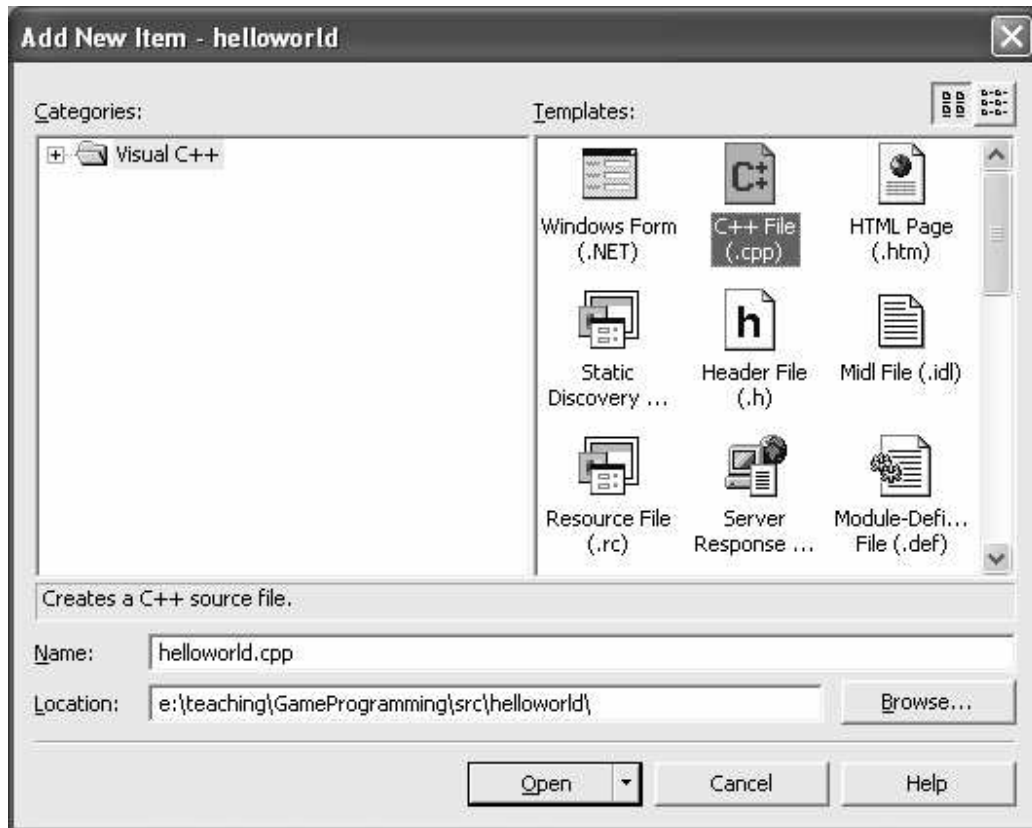
3. Choose applications settings and click empty project.



4. Add a new file by right clicking on source files in the solution explorer and choosing Add->Add new items.



5. Choose a file name and choose c++ file.



6. Write the code and choose Build->Rebuild helloworld when ready. This creates a file in the subdirectory called Debug.
