HEALTH INSURANCE

As a conference participant you should insure yourself as business traveller by taking out individual insurance; details can be obtained from your travel agency. Tourists are covered by public health insurance in Denmark within the limits agreed upon between their own country and the Danish authorities. Foreigners from EU countries, staying in Denmark on a temporary basis, are entitled to free medical treatment in hospitals and casualty wards in the event of sudden illness or an aggravation of a chronic disease, provided the person concerned has not travelled to Denmark with the intention of obtaining treatment and is not physically in a position to return back to his/her own country. Foreigners from most other countries must be insured. The cost of transport from Denmark to the patient's own country must always be paid by the person concerned.

CLIMATE

The weather in Copenhagen in May and June is mainly sunny and warm with temperatures around 20 degrees Celsius. The Nordic climate, however, can be full of surprises, and we recommend that participants bring a raincoat/sweater to ensure they make the most of their stay.

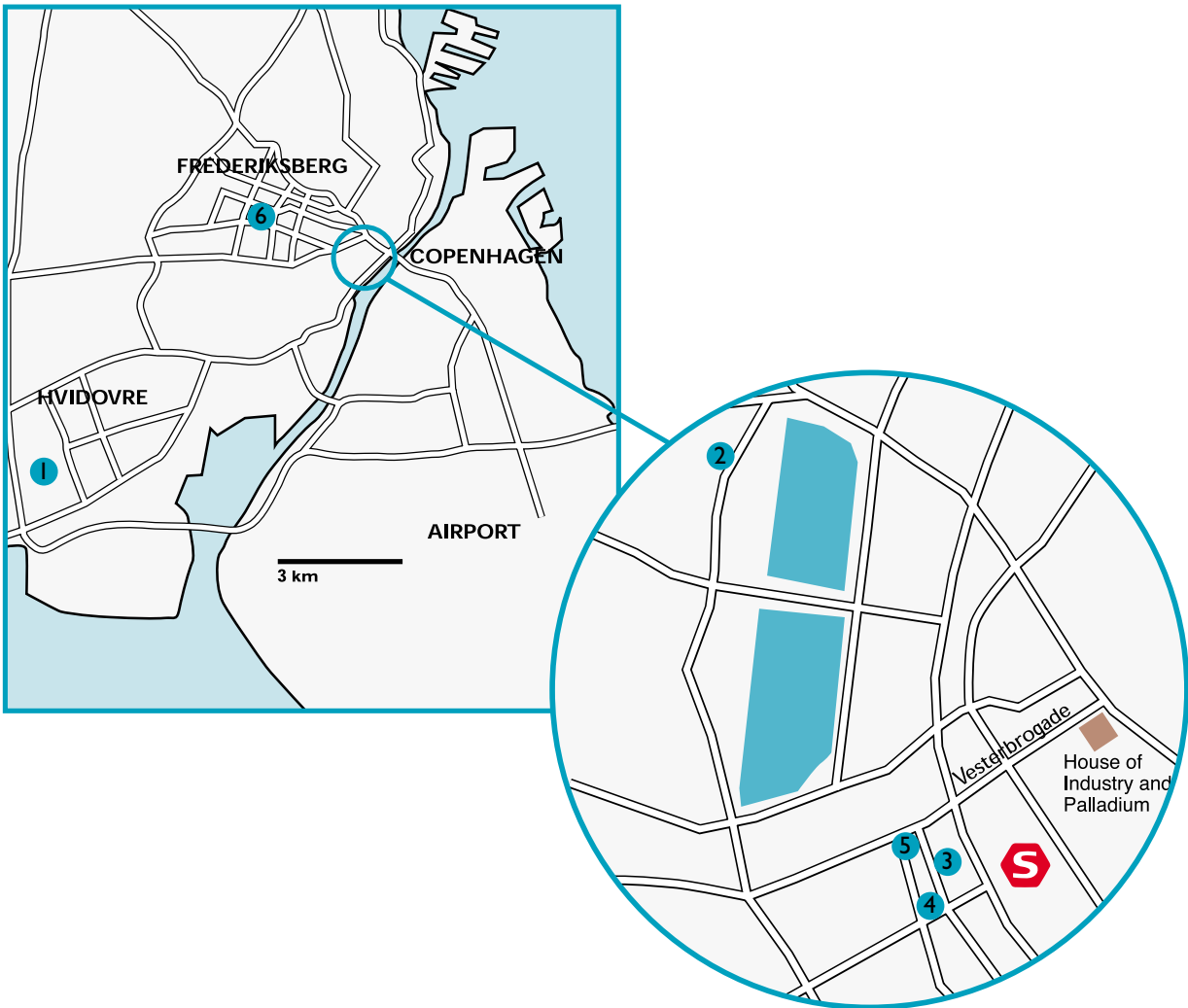
ACCOMMODATION

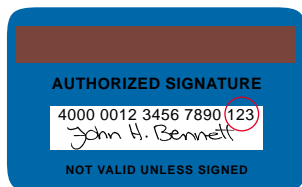
