



Troels Fibæk: Mobile Media, Sociability and Convergence (1-2)


- The main interest of this (PhD) project is how Danish Youth aged 16–19 manage mediated sociability in an environment characterized by increased mobile connectivity and convergent communication media.
- Mobile communication:
 - From 1-to-1 to many-to-many
 - Convergent media and the mobile phone as a "portal"
- Mediated sociability:
 - New mobile social stages
 - New tensions: Availability, participation, and privacy
 - Limited knowledge
- A qualitative approach to explore uses and meanings of technology in everyday life




Finding lost friends on Facebook

- What do people get out of it?




Why would you NOT use technology?






Background:

- Focus on opportinities, risks, harm, and coping strategies
- Evidence based policy making at all levels
- Random stratified sample: ~ 1000 9-16 year old internet users per country
- Total: 25142 internet-users, 25 countries
- Data from child paired with a parent

- Write academic short paper


