

InC Research Seminars

Proposal for autumn 2007 - 1st or 2nd Thursdays every month, 10-12 am

Three different seminar types are proposed.

- PhD seminars in which one or more PhD students outline their research agenda, current challenges or problems. It could also be in the format of presenting a contribution to a journal or a conference. The idea is to see the seminar as inspiration for other researchers as well as supplementary supervision and constructive criticism for the PhD students.
- Resarch project seminars in which one or more project members present the current status or an interesting aspect of a specific research project. It could also be in the format of presenting a contribution to a journal or a conference.
- Guest seminars in which external guests are invited to give a presentation. These could either be from industry or from other research environments. Hot shots or just interesting people.

For all seminars hold that they are open seminars and that external guests are welcome – also to give input to the seminar if the organizers want this. Introductions and material are uploaded to the InC-blog one week in advance.
